

Dear Gulf Beach Weddings Couples, Municipalities, and Employees:

In light of ongoing news regarding the Novel Coronavirus (COVID-19), I want to assure you that your safety, health and wellbeing are of paramount importance to us. In response to the Novel Coronavirus outbreak, we have implemented additional rigorous cleaning and disinfection procedures – by closely monitoring the advice of medical and government authorities to ensure that we maintain a safe environment during your wedding.

- For your safety and ours, we are providing masks and commercial grade hand sanitizing units at the warehouse prior to departure to the ceremony. Any employee showing signs of illness will be asked to stay home and seek guidance from your healthcare provider.
- We kindly suggest guests wear a face mask for high-risk individuals participating in or attending the ceremony.
- To respect physical distancing, spacing at the ceremony site will comply with recommended CDC guidelines: Wedding Coordinators will maintain safe distances, PA System, Live Musician, etc. will also be done from a distance to minimize interaction. \*Please see the recommended Setup Diagram on Page 2 of the attached.
- Materials used for Beach Ceremonies will be disinfected for use out on the beach.
- Office/Warehouse facilities are regularly cleaned to minimize any contagion and surface level spread of any virus or pathogen using recommended alcohol based sanitizers and commercial grade cleaning solutions.
- We feel that an outdoor beach wedding can be the safest nuptial opportunity for a private gathering and will continue to follow the latest CDC measures.
